WEAR A LIFE JACKET

Open water swimming or being towed – wear one.
A life jacket buys time.



KNOW THE RIGHT-OF-WAY

Know who yields.
Head-on, crossing, and passing laws prevent close calls.



RESPECT NO-WAKE ZONES

Idle inside swim buoy lines and channels.
Protect swimmers and your boat.



GIVE TOWING BOATS SPACE

Tubers, skiers, and surfers fall randomly.
Distance saves lives.



EYES UP – LOOK AHEAD

Eyes up while driving a boat, always.
Watch for other boats, paddlecraft, and swimmers.



BE A SOBER CAPTAIN

Designate a sober operator for your boat.
Good captains are sober captains.
